Vice Chair Poole opened the Public Hearing to discuss JRO Enterprises request to create a non-buildable out lot with access to Schaefer Road and Hwy 92 for parcel 23-014-00650000, W3220A Schaeffer Road.

Ed Short, the Surveyor for JRO, presented a map from the Green County Register of Deeds. Ed explained JRO's desire to create the Out lot.

Items discussed:

-the current driveway is not the required 66 foot width the entire length servicing the farmstead.

- The Wilcox lot and Schaefer lot share a driveway.

-residents purchased lots in a "closed loop" subdivision.

- William Wilcox goes on record as denying the giving or exchange of any property for an easement.

- The property is for sale, will it stay the same or be re-sold.
