Senior Center – Friday, 1/11/19 No nutrition person, they are looking to hire but new position description, new handbook for future hires (tabled 1/23/19), employees were using personal cell phones – looking into getting a cell phone, passed budget \$20,302.00 is Exeter's portion, \$20,000.00 will be paid extra on principal of building. Verona is joining Belleville Senior Center and will pay somewhere in the \$40,000.00 range toward budget in 2020.

Supervisor report: Ted – 2 more driveway permits (14 total, compared to 6 in 2017), tree down last Tuesday due to high winds, last Tuesday Fire/EMS meeting (EMS ordered \$250,000.00 new vehicle- funds in the bank). Unfinished Business: Wood Duck Circle drainage issue, Adam Uncles from Attorney's office. Travis DeSmet wrote letter about drainage. Dale Schoeller wrote a letter to attorney. Determine where the water is coming from – underground spring or broken drain tile. SS - 88.90 sub section 1 and 2.

There is poor drainage in the entire subdivision. Condos are dumping water. Green County approved subdivision not Exeter Township. Township has developed a land use plan with accountability by developers.

Town member that lives in the subdivision – boots are wet up to ankle on Schoeller's property not on other properties. Schoeller's are in a flood plain. Martinson Excavating and Kroenig.
